You can view your results online. The attached document provides information on how to access

your results via My Manchester. Remember to select Self Service Enrollment View my Grades.

An alternative method to viewing your grades is as follows: login My Manchester, select Self

Service Enrollment View My Assignments. From there select the academic year that you wish to

review your results for and the click continue (through these screens you can only see one academic

year at a time). From this screen you can see your overall grade but also get details of how this

was made up from your assignment marks and tutorial contributions.

with **Dr. Dewi P. Faeni** as soon as possible to begin the supervision process.

Your submission deadline for your dissertation is Tuesday 3rd January 2017. Students will be

asked to submit their dissertation in electronic form through Blackboard. Please note it is not a

requirement that you produce a bound copy.

All dissertations must now be anonymized, as with all other course work. Therefore, the university

now requires that you put your Student ID number and not your name on title page of your

dissertation.

a copy of the IDPM Dissertation Handbook 2015-16 for your information and a copy of the SEED

Dissertation Title and Ethics Form 2015-16, which is due for return to me no later than 30th

September 2016.

If you have difficulty viewing your results online, you may have had your results withheld due to

a tuition fee debt recorded against your record. I would strongly advise you to contact the Credit

Control Office as soon as possible, either by telephone on 0161 275 8137 or in person by visiting

the Student Service Centre, to clarify what you need to do next. Please do not contact me regarding

this, as I do not have access to the fees side of your record. You must speak to the Credit Control

Office directly to resolve this.

You will not be able to have your results confirmed over the phone. If you are a sponsored student

and require an unofficial transcript of results, you should contact your Programmed Administrator

to request this. Please note we would normally expect 7 days' notice to produce these.
