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

1. Title

I believe that the this manuscript is quite an interesting manuscript and one that needs to be explored more. I think the idea of collecting sensitive data through manipulation and role play methods is rather novel, and I can see that the author has done her/his homework with the data analysis. However, I believe the author needs to summarise this topic into an unclear title. Perhaps adding more context about the new research approach (role play manipulation) and the correlation between research variables: Obedience Pressure and Fraud in Procurement of Goods/Services, for example : the effect of A on B; or the impact of A on B, etc; would provide more understanding to the readers. At its current state, the title is somehow misleading and vague.

2. Support

I suggest that the author enriches this manuscript with 1) some books from fraud's major school of thoughts, such as Donald Cressey; Albreicht; Joseph T Wells. and the like. TAKEN is not designated for articles about fraud, so a bit of introduction on this topic and the definition of fraud can help readers to understand the context and the subject better. 2) some studies on the scenario of experimental module uses a third person context implemented in a research on subjects not about ethics. The author mentioned that role play manipulation is an approach used in ethical research, however, obedience pressure is more about circumstantial research that ethical
